National Championships is open to members of Scottish Deaf Golf Association only.

National Championships is played over the stroke play of 54 holes – 18 holes per day allowing more social time while taking part in this event. Men and Ladies are to play 54 holes of stroke play. Prizes include vouchers for winners and runner-ups and cash for nearest the pin winners.

National Championships is a qualifying event for the selection of Team Scotland on the next year.

Places are limited to 18 players who would be placed on a first come, first served basis upon an entrance <u>form AND fee</u> received by **Scottish Deaf Golf Association**.
